GREEN CERTIFICATION



In July the Law Library applied to renew its green certification with the Cleveland Metropolitan Bar Association. In early August, the Library received the honor of being "Green Certified" for the biennial

The Law Library was also honored at the Bar Association's luncheon for the Second Annual David Webster Greener Way to Work Day. 
