Introduction: Our members and staff were the inspiration for this Index. With increasing frequency, our members ask us to find articles they saw or read in a local journal but cannot remember where, when or by whom. In addition, when our members request research assistance or ask us to conduct a periodical search, we often like to recommend relevant, topical articles from local publications. Because these articles are not indexed in print or online anywhere, we have always relied on the wealth of our staff's collective memory to locate what our patrons need. However, searching for these articles can become an arduous process of thumbing through journal after journal looking for the proverbial "needle in a haystack." In an effort to save our staff time and streamline our patrons' access to these articles, I decided that we needed to create a periodical index that could serve as a new gateway to the authors, titles and subjects contained within these legal gems.

Confident that our members are representative of law library patrons state-wide, I decided to take this project more "global" by including a comprehensive list of journals and law reviews that are or were historically published in Ohio. Once I enlisted the invaluable assistance of my colleague, Anne M^cFarland, it did not take long for this bud to blossom into the Index you are using today. Anne and I entered all of the data ourselves and created the authorized list of subject headings under which the articles are indexed. Although we originally began by using a simple spreadsheet program, we ultimately sought and obtained an AALL research grant from LexisNexis to produce our Index more professionally. The rest of our team helped us with the technical aspects of producing this Index and making it accessible in print and on the Internet. In the future, we plan to continually update this Index with new articles from our current publication list as well as articles from a select list of additional journals.

We hope that our index will serve the in-depth legal research needs of all academic and county law libraries in the state of Ohio and provide a foundation for legal research at public libraries offering legal reference services.
