## TIMELINE: 1970's

**1970**

Law Library Association obtains tax exempt status

OBAR/Mead Data Central Inc. computerized legal research service 1st available at the Law Library

Creation of Xerox copying program

Library inventory conducted

**1971**

Work begins on 1st card catalog with 4 sections for titles, subjects, authors and geographies

Law Library staff begin creating a shelf list of the collection

Creation of Memorial Gallery of pictures of Law Library Presidents

John G. White donates old English law books (later given to CPL)

Law reviews and bar association reports are rebound, reclassified and shelved

**1972**

Law Library purchases 2 more card catalogs

**1973**

Census of Law Library members conducted in Law & Fact

Shelving installed in attic of County Courthouse

**1974**

Placement of stanchion with theater ropes at Law Library entrance

**1975**

Board establishes anti-theft policy

**1976**

Justice Center completed; Law Library acquires entire 4th floor in the County Courthouse

Law Library helps County Commissioners establish law library at the County jail

Law Library adds second copy machine

**1977**

Law Library starts an AV collection

Sign-in policy established at new front desk

**1978**

Law Library undergoes major remodeling

**1979**

Installation of new steel shelving in the Law Library
